


A TREASURE TROVE OF INFLUENCES

The Buttons (ex-Formula One driver Jenson and his interior designer wife Brittny) have curated a home with the charisma of the Riviera and hints of LA power glamour, balanced with earthy tones and organic shapes. Throughout their villa, unique details keep the eye moving as materials flow and handcraft-inspired furniture meets designer pieces. A central living space has a vaulted, suspended hallway that halos around it as curves meet straight lines. This dynamic between straight lines and curvatures continues through the home – arches feature heavily in textured plaster.

Clever use of repetition and an abundance of natural light turn this kitchen by Amy Storm & Company into a functional space with a joyful aesthetic lightness.

Clad in oak and stone, the space has an honest simplicity that's amplified by Storm's use of symmetry. A centrepiece island is spacious and welcoming, with dual mixers and lighting emphasising the symmetry further still.

One touch worth noting is the uniformity of the storage across the rear of the kitchen, with Buster + Punch brass pull bars, giving the space an archive feel. Storm has positioned the taller units on the reverse of the island; hidden from view.



"My home has been built the same way I design and create our products at Buster + Punch. It is based on our philosophy of details being the foundation of interior architecture. Everything inside has been designed and made by myself and my friends in our local workshop, including the staircases, one-off lighting pieces and the kitchen; even our baby gates carry the Buster + Punch attitude and DNA. It means that the static elements of our home remain solid while we're able to evolve things like furniture, art, or lighting as we go through life. Humans adapt and evolve, and I think a home should have that same flexibility. In terms of the art, furniture, and products inside, almost all of them are by the brands and artists that I admire, so I'm in a space that's constantly inspiring me creatively."




Minale's bedroom is restrained and neutral to keep the mood calm and restful. Switches and dimmers by the bed ensure light can be dimmed easily with minimal movement.

Our lighting range and electricity range are both informed by my past as a maker of custom motorcycles and how you make parts for those. They blend function and form in perfect balance. If you take one of our dimmer switches, the beauty comes from the cross-knurl, but it also speaks visually about the function. The knurling, a signature of Buster + Punch from the beginning, can be found on all of our designs involving physical interaction.

"Our Caged lighting, for example, reflects the idea that lighting is art and a way of framing within a space. There needs to be a sense of drama that pulls the eye from the design itself but architecturally, I use light to emphasise parts of an interior. We've gone a long way from one big light that dominates a space and makes huge shadows everywhere. Our lighting is an extension of our hardware and detailing in this sense; it helps to set the tone for everything else in a home." – Massimo Buster Minale

SOFT + REFINED

Situated in a forest plot in Denmark, this home, designed by the architect who lives there, is informed by its location in all respects.

The home itself consists of the residential spaces, a workshop, orangery and a design studio. Clad in a facade of Canadian cedar and with a roof in stealthy black steel, the materials are otherwise mostly Nordic – calm and serene with a focus on warm colours and textures. The home's volumes are elongated and slender, linked together by the materials and details selected.

Furniture, the kitchen, bath and other elements throughout the spaces are also designed by the architect himself using Douglas woods. In such a well composed build like this, no detail is overlooked, with Buster + Punch used throughout.

If proof were ever needed that details are the cornerstone to realising an absolutely stellar interior it's right here, deep in the Danish forests.
